

Section 8 Eggs (Cartoned)

General Considerations

Check catalog for specific requirements and classes.

- Exterior soundness Eggs should be well shaped and smooth, without visible ridges or calcium deposits. Avoid cracked eggs.
- Cleanliness Eggs should be very clean without stains. Avoid eggs with raised adhering dirt such as dirt, yolk or litter and/or prominent large or scattered stains.
- Uniformity Eggs in a carton should be as uniform in size, shape and color as possible. Do not mix brown and white eggs or eggs of different sizes together.
- Good quality eggs protect consumer health. Factors that affect the safety of the product, such as cleanliness, are the most important.
